Cellist

The young cellist Paolo Tedesco, born 2001, began his musical journey at the age 5 at the Suzuki Talent Center in Torino, where he studied and achieved his Suzuki diploma in the class of M. Marco Mosca.

He is first prize winner of several national and international competitions (Competition “Città di Torino”, Competition “Città di Maccagno”, “Salieri” Competition).

Paolo Tedesco has often performed as a soloist and first cellist of the Suzuki Orchestra of Turin, playing in some of the most beautiful venues of Italy and

Europe, such as Teatro Regio (Torino), Teatro Carignano (Torino), Auditorium “G. Agnelli” (Torino), Great Hall of the Conservatory of Turin, Basilica di San Vitale (Ravenna), National Music Forum (Wroclaw-Poland).

He was regular member of Giovanni Sollima’s ensemble “100 cellos”.

The young cellist attended soloistic masterclasses of Prof. Wen-Sinn Yang in Starnberg (Germany) and Seefeld in Tirol (Austria) and a chamber music masterclass of Trio di Parma at the Accademia Perosi (Biella). Furthermore, he collaborated with the Flying Strings Chamber Orchestra, an international ensemble of gifted young musicians, and is a member of Camerata Ducale Junior.

Paolo Tedesco is currently attending the Bachelor of Music at the Conservatory “G. Verdi” in Turin, where he studies with M. Massimo Macri and Prof. Marianna Sinagra.
