Silvia Vendrame, 17 years old, is nowadays attending the third academic year at the Conservatory C. Monteverdi in Cremona under the professor Laura Gorna.

At twelve years old she won the first prize at the Cortemilia International Competition. In the same year she and her sister Katia appeared in a concert for the „Amici del Loggione“ association in the Brera museum of arts in Milan. She then obtained the „Kiwanis“ scholarship as one of the best Conservatory students in 2013 and also in 2015, playing for that occasion at the Filodrammatici Theater in Cremona. Later she also performed at the Museo del violino for the Festival Stradivari and in Bergamo at the „Teatro delle Grazie“. In 2016 and 2017 she performed in Freiburg at the chastle of Ebnet for a classical music festival. She then obtained other prizes at competitions such as Piove di Sacco or Salieri competition in Varese.

Every summer she takes part of the „Chianti in musica“ masterclass, studying chamber music in duo, under the guidance of Mariagrazia Bellocchio. Moreover in 2018 she got accepted at the „Akademie Václava Hudečka“ in Czech Republic and performed in concerts in the town of Luhačovice.

From 2018 she plays with Camerata Ducale Junior, one of the most important string young orchestra in Italy

At the moment she is at her forth year of study at the D. Manin humanistic high school in Cremona.
